

MEDICAL ALERT CARD

PLEASE SEE BOTH SIDES OF THIS CARD FOR IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING MY PRE-EXISTING CONDITION.

I have a disease known as Lewy Body Dementia (LBD). I may show signs of CONFUSION, DIFFICULTY UNDERSTANDING/RESPONDING TO QUESTIONS, OR MAY ACT IN AN AGGRESSIVE MANNER. Other symptoms may be VISUAL HALLUCINATIONS or MISIDENTIFYING PEOPLE.

VERY IMPORTANT: AVOID ADMINISTERING
TRADITIONAL ANTIPSYCHOTIC MEDICATIONS,
i.e. Haloperidol (Haldol) and ANTIEMETIC DRUGS,
i.e., Prochlorperazine (Compazine) since treatment
with these and certain antipsychotic medications
may contribute to SEVERE, IRREVERSIBLE
CONDITIONS. ADVERSE REACTIONS MAY ALSO
BE EXPERIENCED BY MEDICATIONS THAT AFFECT
THE BRAIN, i.e., Valium, Benadryl, Ambien, as well as
some bladder-control drugs.

This card has been printed to bring awareness of the symptoms and sensitivity to medications that people with LBD may experience. Each individual is different. The best professionals to consult are knowledgeable neurologists, geriatricians, and geriatric psychiatrists.
